1. INTRODUCTION

Information to be given: The aim of the experiment and the intended result.
Literature knowledge about the experiment

2. MATERIALS AND METHOD

Information to be given: The steps performed in the experiment (must not be copied from the Laboratory Manuel!)
Formulas and explanations to be used in experimental calculations (no calculations should be made!)

3. RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Information to be given: Data and calculations obtained as a result of the experiments
Interpretation of experiment results (experiment should not be summarized, results should be interpreted in an original way)

4. REFERENCES

Information to be given: All non-original information should be given with references in **APA** format.

GENERAL WRITING RULES:

- The text should be in Times New Roman, 12 font size, 1.15 line spacing and justified.
- Abbreviations should be written in a spelled-out version first, and abbreviations without explanation should not be used. (For example, after it is specified as Yıldız Technical University (YTU), it can be given in the text as YTU)
- Pages should be numbered from the bottom center.
- Titles should be numbered in Times New Roman, 12 points, capital letters and bold.
- New main headings should not be created, subheadings should be written as 1.1, 1.1.1.
- Tables and Figures should be numbered sequentially starting from the number of the main title, Times New Roman, 12 points and centered. (For example, Table 2.3 for the 3rd Table given under the 2nd Title)
- The title of the table should be written above the table and the title of the figure should be written below the figure.

REPORT SCORING WILL BE DONE ACCORDING TO REPORT CONTENT, REPORT FORMAT AND GENERAL WRITING RULES.
